## **Green Deal Installer authorisation for Hot Water Systems**with Heat Recovery

The recent launch of the Green Deal Home Improvement Fund (GDHIF) offers cash back to consumer for 13 energy efficiency measures including "waste water heat recovery system". Following the launch of the (GDHIF) on the 1st May, the GD ORB have received queries relating to the certification requirements for this measure.

The GD ORB would like to clarify that energy efficiency measure "waste water heat recovery system" falls under Annex C7 of PAS 2030:2014 Edition 1 within the BSM category "Hot water systems" (BSM.7). The measure description in Annex C7 is provided as "Hot water systems including hot water systems with heat recovery". The Annex C7 is further split into two sub-measures – "Domestic hot water systems" (BSM.7.1) and "Non-domestic hot water systems" (BSM.7.2) – for domestic and non-domestic properties, respectively.

The GD ORB would like to emphasise to Green Deal Certification Bodies and Green Deal Installers that Green Deal Installers must hold certification for Annex C7 "Hot Water systems", in order to be authorised to install "waste water heat recovery systems" under the GDHIF and/or the Green Deal. Under the GD ORB Register, the Green Deal Installers will be listed as authorised for installing "Waste water heat recovery devices attached to showers".

This requirement was included in the previous version of the PAS 2030, therefore the GD ORB does not anticipate any additional accreditation/ certification requirements due to the new PAS 2030:2014 Edition 1 coming into force on 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2014. However, Green Deal Installers are advised to contact their Certification Body to confirm their authorisation to for this measure as all competencies must be assessed within this Annex.

Green Deal Certification Bodies are advised to contact the United Kingdom Accreditation Service (UKAS) for any queries they may have in relation to their accreditation.
